### Landscaping Committee

- At our request, the ACC Landscaping Department has removed the fallen cypress trees along the Ponderosa Drive entrance.
- ACC Leaf and Limb pickup is off schedule due to multiple holidays and is working to get back on track. July pick-up in our area starts July 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Remember to put your leaves and limbs **ONLY** on your property and not so close to power poles or mailboxes as to make it difficult for workers to collect.
- Each residence is allowed one "load" per collection; defined as a pile 6 ft long by 6 ft high by 4.5 ft deep with limbs no more than 4 inches in diameter.

### Fact

The CDC estimates that for the US in 2021, about 693,021 people died from heart disease, 604,553 people died from cancer., and 415,399 died from complications related to a confirmed or presumed Covid 19 infection. At the same time, deaths from influenza/pneumonia dropped out of the top 10 causes of death (#8 in 2018, #9 in 2019 and 2020, #13 in 2021).
