Dessert Recipe from the CCCA Recipe Exchange Group

No-bake Berries and Creamy Things Dessert (Angel food cake with a berry & yogurt compote)

Ingredients (amounts are approximate)

- 1/2 of a store-bought angel food cake cut into very small pieces
- 4 oz of Cool Whip - thawed
- 2 containers lime yogurt
- 1 jar of Lemon Curd (Trader Joe's used in original recipe)
- 1 pint of sweet berries (either strawberries cut into quarters, or blueberries or blackberries). Divide into 3 equal portions but save a few for final topping.

Building the dish

A straight sided, tall, narrow, glass container works best, although any glass bowl with straight sides will do.

1. Combine the yogurt and lemon curd.
2. Place a layer of cake, about 1/3 of your pieces, in the dish.
3. Add 1/3 of the yogurt/lemon curd over the cake.
4. Top with 1/3 of the berries.
5. Repeat steps 2-4 two more times.
6. Top with the thawed Cool Whip
7. Add a few berries to the top.
8. Cover and refrigerate for at least two hours. Chilling overnight works just as well.
